SUBSEA 7 GRADUATE ENGINEERING AND CONVERSION PROGRAMMES WIN MAJOR INDUSTRY AWARD

Subsea 7 has won the Tremendous Training and Development Award at this year's Cherries ceremony in recognition of its innovative Engineering Conversion Programme and highly successful Graduate Engineering Development Scheme (GEDS).

The award, which recognises excellence in the field of human resources, was presented to Subsea 7 at an awards ceremony on 7 June attended by hundreds of leading HR professionals in Aberdeen, Scotland.

Gavin Hedge, after over 20 years as an engineer in the RAF, in 2006 joined Subsea 7's Engineering Conversion Programme. Today, Gavin is the Specialist Technical Services Manager with a department of 25 people. He also leads the Safety Engineering & Technical Risk Team. Gavin said: "I feel lucky that Subsea 7 believed in me early on, investing in converting me from an aircraft engineer into the world of subsea through training and development."

Now in its fifth year, the highly sought after Cherries Awards has become tougher as the calibre of HR, recruitment and training achievements has continued to be outstanding.
